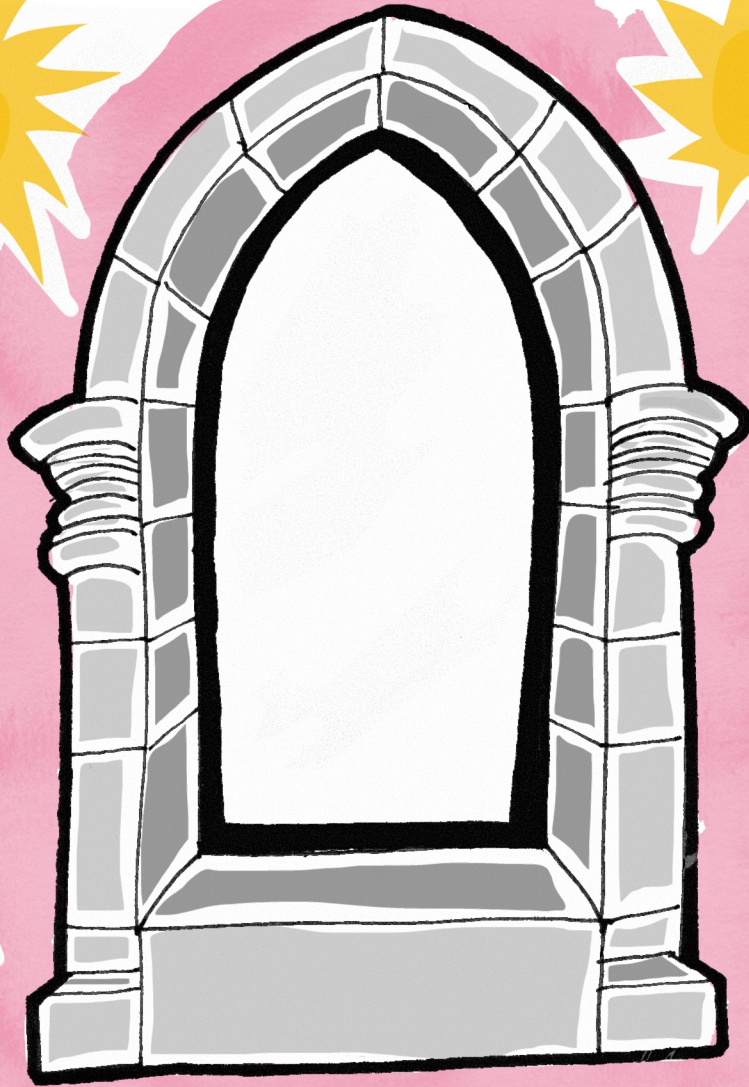


What story would you choose for a stained glass window? Draw it below.

Christ Church Children's trail

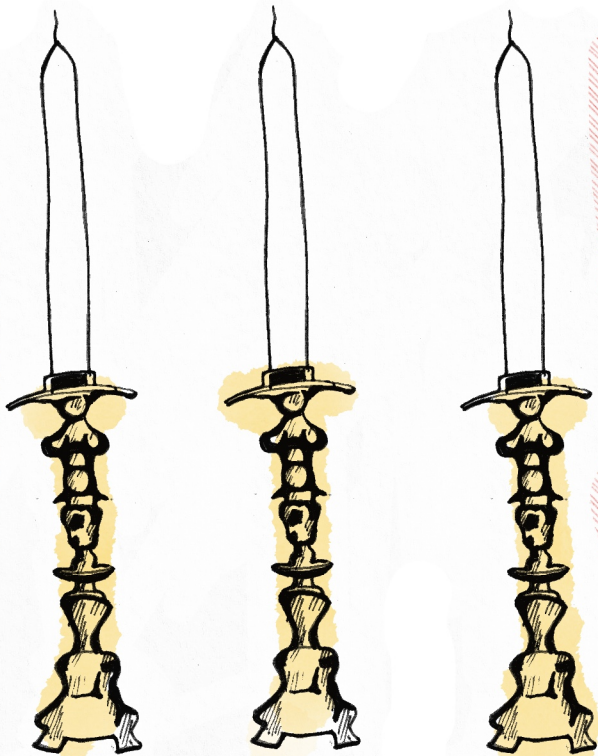


Christ Church was built in 1875. This was the Victorian era. Who was the Queen?

1. How many large silver lamps can you see in front of the altar?



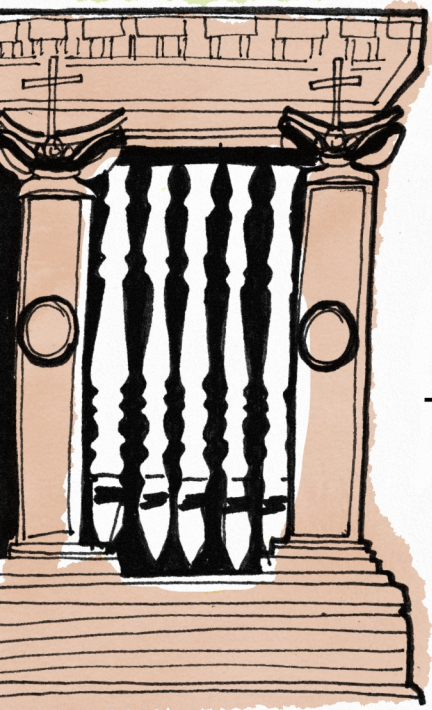
2. How many large candles can you see above the altar?

5. Look back to the high altar and then to the left to the Lady chapel.

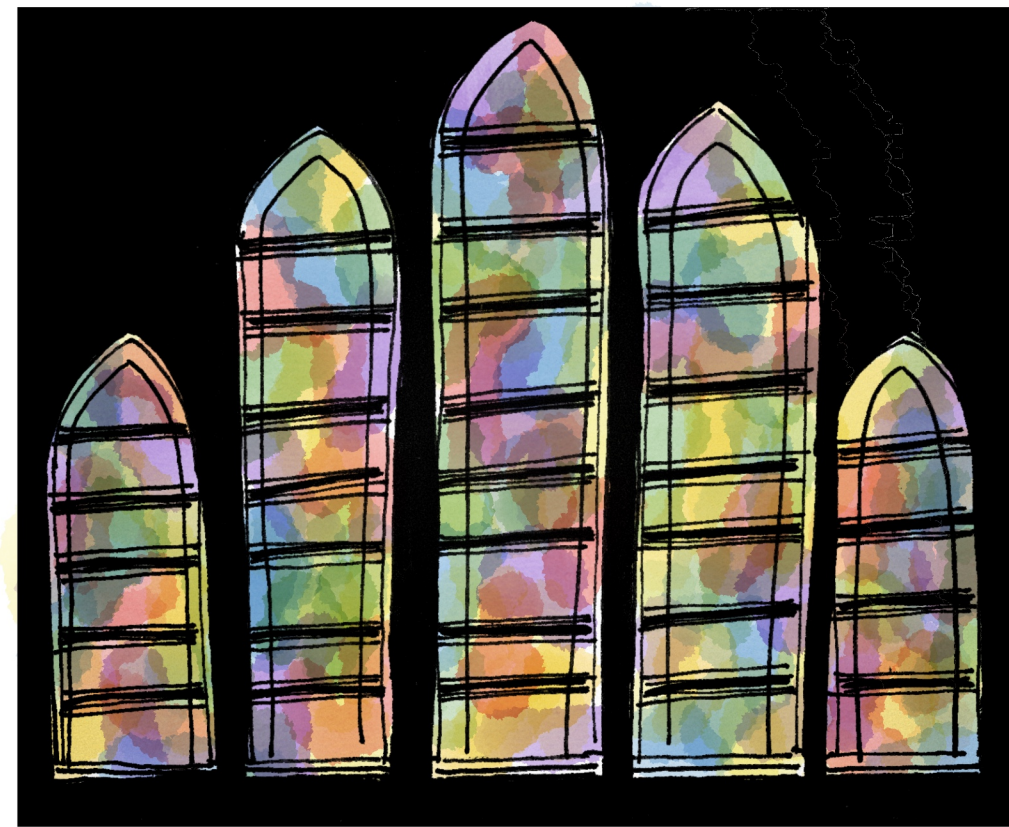
Can you find a picture of a lamb carrying a flag? Can you draw it in the space above?
